INSTRUCTIONS & REQUIREMENTS

THINGS TO DO IN ADVANCE: Buy or borrow the appropriate merit badge book(s). Study all information for each badge and complete the prerequisites shown above. Come dressed in Class A uniform. Be prepared to discuss, report, demonstrate and be tested on all requirements.

THINGS TO BRING: (a) Proof of completion for all prerequisites, signed by Scoutmaster or other adult; (b) A completed “Blue Card” for each merit badge desired, signed by Scoutmaster (no Blue Cards will be issued on-site); (c) The merit badge book for each class you will attend; (d) A notebook, pens or pencils, and other materials called for in each merit badge book.

Each merit badge counselor has the right and authority to approve or disapprove prior work done if, in his or her judgment, it is not up to standards or not properly documented. All BSA requirements will be strictly followed. Parents and Scout leaders are welcome. Each troop should be accompanied and supervised by an appropriate number of adult leaders. Due to class size limits, enrollment priority will be 1st: by registration postmark, 2nd: by rank of 1st Class & above for Eagle required badges.
